Water/Sewer Maintenance I/II

The City of Winnemucca is hiring a full-time Water/Sewer Maintenance I/II employee in the Public Works Department. The salary range for this position is \$35,275-\$53,524, depending on experience. The City of Winnemucca provides excellent benefits, including PERS, paid medical, dental, and vision insurance and paid annual and sick leave.

This position will be filled at the Maintenance I or Maintenance II level depending on experience. Incumbents perform the more routine technical duties while learning operational policies and procedures.

Examples of essential job functions include:

- Control and monitor mechanical devices used to treat wastewater and related sludges, both manually and using the Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) and computer control systems.
- Maintain water and sewer plant equipment, and repairs equipment as needed.
- Maintain well and equipment logs.
- Inspect all pumps, bar screen and related equipment, grit chambers, digesters and heaters, trickling filters, and primary and secondary basins daily and record all vital information on production totals.
- Conduct water sampling for diagnostic testing purposes.
- Calculate chemical dosage for water treatment.
- Investigate all components of water and sewer operations such as plumbing, electrical, and chemical.
- Install, repair, and read water meters.
- Clean and lubricate pumps and other production equipment as needed.
- Locate water and distribution service lines.
- Keep various records of water and sewer plant operations.
- Engage in public contact with customers and related field personnel.

The successful candidate will have, or have the ability, to obtain a class B Commercial Drivers License within six months of employment.
