

**CITY COUNCIL MINUTES  
SPECIAL MEETING  
NOVEMBER 13, 2020**

The Winnemucca City Council met in special session on Friday November 13, 2020 at 9:00 a.m. in the City Hall meeting room. Present (at the meeting room): Mayor Richard Stone; Council members Mike Owens, Vince Mendiola, Jim Billingsley and Paige Brooks; and, City Manager/Engineer Alicia Heiser and City Attorney Kent Maher. Present (via video conference): Council member Theresa Mavity.

**CALL TO ORDER:**

Mayor Stone called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

**PUBLIC COMMENT-PERSONAL COMMUNICATION-CORRESPONDENCE:**

There was no public comment, personal communication or correspondence.

**BUSINESS ITEMS:**

**BUSINESS IMPACT DETERMINATION**

After review and consideration of the effect each item could potentially have on a "business," as the term is defined by statute, the Council agreed and Council member Mendiola moved to make a finding that no item on the agenda appears to impose a direct and significant economic burden on a business or appears to directly restrict the formation, operation or expansion of a business. Motion carried unanimously.

**2020 GENERAL CITY ELECTION / VOTE CANVASS / ELECTION RESULTS REPORT-DECLARATION**

A summary Statement of Votes Cast with the voting statistics for the 2020 general city election was presented for review. No clerical errors were discovered, and no changes were made to the Statement of Votes Cast. City Attorney Maher provided a proposed resolution to acknowledge the canvass and certify the vote to the Secretary of State.

Council member Brooks moved to approve proposed Resolution 2020-19 which confirmed that: (i) returns from all precincts and districts within the City were received by the City Council and Mayor and canvassed; (ii) no clerical errors were discovered in the returns, no changes were made to the election results, and the results declared the actual and true vote cast; and, (iii) Pamela Coats is declared elected to the office of Council Seat 5 of the City of Winnemucca effective November 17, 2020. Motion carried unanimously.

The City Clerk will: (i) certify the abstract; (ii) make a copy of the certified abstract; (iii) make a mechanized report of the abstract in compliance with regulations adopted by the Secretary of State; (iv) transmit a copy of the certified abstract and the mechanized report of the abstract to the Secretary of State; and, (v) transmit a copy of the certified abstract to each public library in the City, or post on a website maintained by the City, all in compliance with the applicable law.

Mayor Stone presented outgoing Council member Brooks with a plaque and thanked her for the dedication and years of service she provided to the City of Winnemucca.
