

**CITY COUNCIL MINUTES  
JOINT MEETING  
CITY COUNCIL AND HUMBOLDT COUNTY COMMISSION  
JUNE 06, 2022**

The Winnemucca City Council met in a joint session with the Humboldt County Commission on Monday, June 6, 2022 at 8:30 a.m. in-person and via video conference and teleconference. City Officials-Staff present: Mayor Richard Stone; Council members Mike Owens, Theresa Mavity, Vince Mendiola, Jim Billingsley and Pam Coats; City Manager Alicia Heiser; and, City Attorney Kent Maher. County Officials-Staff present: Board Chairman Jim French; Commissioners Ron Cerri, Jesse Hill, Tom Hoss and Ken Tipton; County Manager Dave Mendiola; Deputy District Attorney Wendy Maddox; and, County Comptroller Gina Rackley. Present via video conference: County Treasurer Rhona Lecumberry; Assistant County Manager Abel Del Real-Nava; County Assessor Andy Heiser; and, Michelle Cook.

**CALL TO ORDER:**

Mayor Stone called the City Council portion of the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m.

**PUBLIC COMMENT-PERSONAL COMMUNICATION-CORRESPONDENCE:**

There was no public comment.

**BUSINESS ITEMS:**

**BUSINESS IMPACT DETERMINATION**

After review and consideration of the effect each item could potentially have on a “business,” as the term is defined by statute, the Council agreed and Council member Owens moved to make a finding that no item on the agenda appears to impose a direct and significant economic burden on a business or appears to directly restrict the formation, operation, or expansion of a business. Motion carried unanimously.

**FY 2022-2023 CITY-COUNTY COST SHARE AGREEMENT**

City Manager Heiser reviewed the proposed City-County cost sharing agreement for fiscal year 2022-2023 which provides for sharing of the net operational costs for various City-County functions calculated as a previously agreed upon percentage for each entity as follows:

Airport operations (\$23,387.50): County 50% and City 50% (Note: a negative value indicates a net revenue);  
Cemetery \$165,250: County 25% and City 75% plus capital costs of \$131,437.50;  
Parks \$601,650: County 40% and City 60% plus capital costs of \$43,500;  
Golf Course \$255,700: County 40% and City 60% plus capital costs of \$69,000;  
Swimming pools \$192,500: County 40% and City 60% plus capital costs of \$1,000;  
Recreation \$111,500: County 40% and City 60% plus capital costs of \$28,500;  
Animal Control \$33,000: County 50% and City 50%; and,  
Spay/Neuter Program \$66,000: County 50% and City 50%.

The City share of County functions include:

Building Inspector 35% for a total of \$40,000;  
Planning 25% for a total of \$22,599;  
Dispatch 30% for a total of \$277,798; and,  
Economic Development 50% for a total of \$55,262.

Heiser also commented on additional items that are shared costs but not part of the cost share agreement, including: Insect Control at \$180,000, County 50% and City 50%; and, the Airport construction program at \$1,552,333 in FAA projects planned for the fiscal year with a grant of \$1,455,312.50 and a local contribution of \$97,020.50, County 50% and City 50%.

Council member Owens moved to approve the City-County cost share agreement as presented based on the recommendation of staff. Motion carried unanimously.

Commissioner French made the same motion for the County, which carried unanimously.

**INSECT CONTROL**

County Manager Mendiola stated he will be adding new maps to the RFP (for insect control) and stated Mormon cricket control is not combined with the current mosquito and blackfly control. Robin Gray with Seven Valleys (current control operator) will not come back to assist with insect control after this year. Hopefully, the RFP will yield proposals for a replacement.

No action was taken.

**PUBLIC COMMENT:**

There was no public comment.

Mayor Stone adjourned the Winnemucca City Council at 8:55 a.m.
